## Exceptional Extras The New Special Models

**With the Boxster S Porsche Design Edition 2 and the Cayman S Sport, Porsche is expanding its model range in the mid-engine sports-car segment. The main attraction: at 303 hp (223 kW) and 3.4-liter engine displacement, the two newcomers have 8 hp more output than the respective S editions.**

Two new models, the Boxster S Porsche Design Edition 2 and the Cayman S Sport, will arrive at Porsche Dealers later this fall. And they have a tough act to follow; their predecessors, the Cayman S Porsche Design Edition 1 and the Boxster RS 60 Spyder, have both been very successful.

The new Boxster S Porsche Design Edition 2 comes in any color, as long as it's Carrara White—and that means all over. The star-spoke rims of the 19-inch custom SportDesign wheels, the side air intakes, the center console, and the dials of the three round instruments are all painted white. And the unique accessory included in the sales price is also an homage to the whiteness of the tachometer and the speedometer. The Porsche Design men's watch "Edition 2 Chronograph" from the Dashboard Collection has a white face and was developed especially for this Boxster.

The Cayman S Sport presents itself in flashier colors. It is available in the standard GT3 RS colors orange and green, with the model name on the sides. Black, Guards Red, Speed Yellow, and Carrara White are also offered, as is Arctic Silver Metallic, for an extra charge. As with the GT3 RS, the black rims, the outside rearview mirrors, and the air intake bars provide a sporty contrast. Along with the 303-hp six-cylinder boxer engine, the standard Porsche Active Suspension Management (PASM),

with the chassis lowered ten millimeters and the five-millimeter spacers behind the 19-inch custom SportDesign wheels, provides impressive driving dynamics.

Both models are limited-production: 500 units of the Boxster S Porsche Design Edition 2 and 700 units of the Cayman S Sport will be available worldwide.
